- 3) Make your setting a place where young people feel safe to express their concerns and feel listened to.
- 4) Have a robust, up to date anti-bullying policy, we can help you with that.
- 5) Have E safety and cyberbullying awareness raising activities.
- 6) Make bullying an issue which is regularly covered during PSHE and assemblies.
- 7) Give parents guidelines and sources of help if they have a bullying concern.
- 8) Have a good peer support scheme with well trained and supported young people involved.
